On the 30<sup>th</sup> of this month, Swiss students will complete their university applications. Their places will be confirmed in July upon the submission of a successful "maturité" or high school graduation degree. For university admission, there are no other requirements for Swiss students. It is not like in Türkiye where a university entry exam is mandatory or like in other countries where grades and tests must be presented and/or taken for admission to select universities.

In addition, Swiss institutions are highly regarded and prestigious. According to QS university rankings, Switzerland has 6 universities which are placed among the top 150 globally. In comparison, Germany has only 5 institutions in the top 150, France 4, Italy 2 and Austria 1.

However, studying at a Swiss university is no small feat. Only 44% of the adult population in Switzerland has a university or vocational tertiary education. Not only is obtaining the "maturité" difficult, but entering university is also no guarantee of a degree. A striking statistic comes from EPFL where a rigorous selection process occurs in the first year, known as the propaedeutic cycle, during which students must pass a block examination of all their courses. 60% of all first-year students fail, with ratios sometimes exceeding 70% in departments such as Electrical Engineering and Physics.

As a result, in this edition we wanted to tell you a little bit more about École Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne or EPFL, one of the two federal universities in the country alongside École Polytechnique de Zurich (ETH). These two universities are funded by the federal government and not by their cantonal governments, and rank in the top 20 universities of the world. At EPFL, the department of Electrical and Micro Engineering, and the department of Materials are ranked in the top 10 among such departments worldwide.

Founded on 7 November 1853 (before ETH), EPFL initially operated under the name École Spéciale de Lausanne, focusing on material sciences, architecture and civil engineering to train talented engineers in Switzerland. It gained university status in 1890. Its first female graduate in 1907 was Genevese Cécile Butticaz, with a degree in electrical engineering. She is also the first woman graduate in Europe in this field.

The school attained its federal status in 1969 and was officially named EPFL. Its campus in Écublens-Dorigny was inaugurated in 1978. Since then, EPFL has been committed not only to providing the best education to its students but also to keeping Swiss companies and technology at the forefront globally. Science Park Foundation on the school campus fosters relationships between the business and academia.

Notable professors and alumni include Maryna Viazovska, only the second female Fields Medal recipient in the world; Nobel Prize winner Jacques Dubochet; George de Mestral, inventor of Velcro; Eric Favre, inventor of Nespresso; and André Borschberg, our member and founder of Solar Impulse, the only solar-powered aircraft to circumnavigate the earth. In addition, EPFL serves as the official scientific advisor of Alinghi, twice winners of the America's Cup.

We wish all the "maturants" of this year good luck in their final months of the school year, a very Happy April 23 Children's Day to all the children and a Happy Ramadan Bayram.

#### <u>Kız Kulesi Has Reopened</u>

After an extensive renovation, one of İstanbul's iconic landmarks, Kız Kulesi (Maiden's Tower), reopened on March 1st. The renovation has been thorough, drawing upon techniques and materials documented in the archival records. Following the renovation, subtle military architectural details emerged, distancing it somewhat from the earlier mystique and nostalgic white look associated with the princess who was hiding there from her fate, a fate that ultimately found her anyway, concealed in a basket of figs.

The boats for accessing the tower currently operate only from the Karaköy Pier, as the Salacak Pier in Üsküdar is under renovation.
